## **Council Regulations 24 of 2002**

## **Academic and Other Posts**

Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002

All Souls (G. M. Young) Lecturer in Nineteenth- and Twentieth-century English Literature

- 1. There shall be an All Souls (G. M. Young) Lecturer in Nineteenth- and Twentieth-century English Literature.
- 2. The lecturer shall be appointed by an electoral board consisting of:
  - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the Warden of All Souls College is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council on the occurrence of a vacancy to act for the Warden on that occasion;
  - (2) the Warden of All Souls College, or, if the Warden is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the Governing Body of All Souls College on the occurrence of a vacancy to act for him or her on that occasion;
  - (3)-(5) three persons appointed by the Board of the Faculty of English Language and Literature;
  - (6) a person appointed by the governing body of the college with which the General Board has agreed that the lecturership shall on that occasion be associated.
- 3. The lecturer shall lecture and give instruction in Nineteenth- and Twentieth-century English Literature on such conditions and with such duties as the General Board shall from time to time determine.
