

## **Council Regulations 24 of 2002**

### **Academic and Other Posts**

*Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002*

*Barnett Professor of Social Policy*

*[Amended by the Planning and Resource Allocation Committee of Council on 17 May 2013 and by the General Purposes Committee of Council on 2 February 2018 (Gazette, Vol.148, p.212, 18 January 2018).]*

1. The Barnett Professor of Social Policy shall undertake research, lecture and give instruction in Social Policy.
2. The professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
  - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the head of the college specified in (2) of this clause is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council;
  - (2) the head of the college to which the professorship shall be for the time being allocated by Council under any regulations in that behalf, or, if the head is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the governing body of the college;
  - (3) a person appointed by the governing body of the college specified in (2) of this clause;
  - (4), (5) two persons appointed by Council;
  - (6) one person appointed by the Social Sciences Board;
  - (7)-(9) three persons appointed by the Department of Social Policy and Intervention.
3. The professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the regulations concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same regulations which are applicable to this chair.
