

Council Regulations 24 of 2002

Academic and Other Posts

Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002

DeepMind Professor of Artificial Intelligence

Made by the General Purposes Committee of Council, 22 November 2019, (Gazette, Vol.150, p.96, 7 November 2019).

1. The DeepMind Professor of Artificial Intelligence shall undertake research in and shall lecture and give instruction in artificial intelligence and generally promote its study in the University.
2. The Professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
 - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or if the head of the college specified in (2) of this clause is the Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (2) the head of the college to which the professorship shall be for the time being allocated by Council, or, if the head is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the Governing Body of that college on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (3) a person appointed by the governing body of the college specified in (2);
 - (4), (5) two persons appointed by Council;
 - (6) a person appointed by the Mathematical, Physical and Life Sciences Board;
 - (7)–(9) three persons appointed by the Department of Computer Science
3. The Professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the regulations concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same regulations, which are applicable to the Chair.
