

## **Council Regulations 24 of 2002**

### **Academic and Other Posts**

*Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002*

#### *Drummond Professor of Political Economy*

1. The Drummond Professor of Political Economy shall lecture and give instruction in the principles and history of Political Economy.
2. The professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
  - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the Warden of All Souls College is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
  - (2) the Warden of All Souls College, or, if the Warden is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the Governing Body of All Souls College on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
  - (3) a person appointed by the Governing Body of All Souls College;
  - (4) a person appointed by Council;
  - (5) one person elected by the Board of the Faculty of Modern History;
  - (6), (7) two persons elected by the Board of the Faculty of Social Studies
3. The professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the decree concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same decree which are applicable to this chair.
