## **Council Regulations 24 of 2002**

## **Academic and Other Posts**

Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002

Lecturer (or Reader) in Diplomatic

- 1. There shall be a Lecturer in Diplomatic who shall be elected by a board consisting of:
  - (1) the Vice-Chancellor;
  - (2) the Regius Professor of Modern History;
  - (3) the Chichele Professor of Medieval History;
  - (4) the Regius Professor of Ecclesiastical History;
  - (5)-(7) three persons appointed by the Board of the Faculty of Modern History.
- 2. The General Board may from time to time determine, on the recommendation of the Board of the Faculty of Modern History, that the lecturer shall be designated Reader in Diplomatic.
- 3. The lecturer (or reader) shall lecture and give instruction on such conditions and with such duties as the General Board shall from time to time determine.
