

Council Regulations 24 of 2002

Academic and Other Posts

Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002

Marshal Foch Professor of French Literature

1. The Marshal Foch Professor of French Literature shall lecture and give instruction in French Literature and shall promote generally the study of that subject in the University.
2. The professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
 - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the head of the college specified in (4) of this clause is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (2), (3) two persons appointed by the Council of the University of Paris;
 - (4) the head of the college to which the professorship shall be for the time being allocated by Council under any decree in that behalf, or, if the head is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the governing body of the college on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (5) a person appointed by the governing body of the college specified in (4) of this clause;
 - (6) a person appointed by Council;
 - (7) a person appointed by the General Board;
 - (8), (9) two persons elected by the Board of the Faculty of Medieval and Modern Languages.
3. The professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the decree concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same decree which are applicable to this chair.
