Nuffield Professor of Anaesthetic Science

[Amended by the Planning and Resource Allocation Committee of Council on 18 January 2007]

- 1. The Nuffield Professor of Anaesthetic Science shall lecture and give instruction in Anaesthetics.
- 2. The professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
 - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the Master of Pembroke College is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (2) the Master of Pembroke College, or, if the Master is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the governing body of the college on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (3) a person appointed by the Governing Body of Pembroke College;
 - (4), (5) two persons appointed by Council;
 - (6)-(9) four persons appointed by the Medical Sciences Board;
 - (10) a person appointed by the body or bodies which may issue an honorary clinical contract or contracts to the professor.

At least three members of the board, one of whom shall be a professor, shall hold clinical appointments.

3. The professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the regulations concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same regulations which are applicable to this chair.
