Papiya Ghosh Prize

[Made by the General Purposes Committee of Council on 5 June 2008]

- 1. The benefaction from Mr Saurev Sen, which comprises £4,200, together with any further donations for this purpose, shall be known as the Papiya Ghosh Prize (the 'Fund').
- 2. The University shall retain all of the Fund as a permanent endowment and shall apply the net income towards an annual prize for the best M.Phil in Development Studies.
- 3. The administration of the Fund, and the application of its income, shall be the responsibility of the Board of Management comprising:
 - (1) the Head of the Department of International Development;
 - (2) the Director of Graduate Studies in the Department of International Development;
 - (3) the Course Director for the M.Phil in Development Studies in the Department of International Development.
- 4. Regulations 1 and 3 above may be amended by Council.
