

Council Regulations 24 of 2002

Academic and Other Posts

Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002

Professor of Applied Statistics

[Amended by the Planning and Resource Allocation Committee on 29 January 2016 (Gazette, Vol. 146, p. 223-224, 14 January 2016)]

1. The Professor of Applied Statistics shall undertake research in Applied Statistics and shall lecture and give instruction in that subject and generally promote its study in the University.
2. The professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
 - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the head of the college specified in (2) of this clause is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (2) the head of the college to which the professorship shall be for the time being allocated by Council, or, if the head is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the governing body of the college on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (3) a person appointed by the governing body of the college specified in (2) of this clause;
 - (4), (5) two persons appointed by Council;
 - (6) a person appointed by the Mathematical, Physical and Life Sciences Board;
 - (7) a person appointed by the Medical Sciences Board;
 - (8), (9) two persons appointed by the Department of Statistics.
3. The professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the regulations concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same regulations which are applicable to this chair.
