

Council Regulations 24 of 2002

Academic and Other Posts

Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002

Professor of Evidence-Based Intervention and Policy Evaluation

[Amended by the Planning and Resource Allocation Committee of Council on 26 June 2015 (Gazette, Vol. 145, p. 630, 11 June 2015)]

1. The Professor of Evidence-Based Intervention and Policy Evaluation shall engage in advanced study and research and shall lecture and give instruction in the field of evidence-based social intervention and policy evaluation.
2. The professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
 - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the head of the college specified in (2) below is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council;
 - (2) the head of the college to which the professorship shall be for the time being allocated by Council under any regulation in that behalf, or if the head is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the governing body of the college;
 - (3) a person appointed by the governing body of the college specified in (2) above;
 - (4), (5) two persons appointed by Council;
 - (6) a person appointed by the Social Sciences Board;
 - (7)–(9) three persons appointed by the Department of Social Policy and Intervention.
3. The professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the regulations concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same regulations which are applicable to the Chair.
