

Council Regulations 24 of 2002

Academic and Other Posts

Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002

Professor of Geochemistry

*[Amended on the Planning and Resource Allocation Committee on 19 February 2004
(Gazette, Vol. 134, p. 624, as corrected on 31 May 2012)]*

1. The Professor of Geochemistry shall undertake research in Geochemistry and shall lecture and give instruction in that subject.
2. The professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
 - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the Principal of St Hugh's College is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council;
 - (2) the Principal of St Hugh's College, or if the head is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the Governing Body of St Hugh's College;
 - (3) a person appointed by the Governing Body of St Hugh's College;
 - (4),(5) two persons appointed by Council
 - (6)–(9) four persons appointed by the Mathematical and Physical Sciences Board.
3. The professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the decree concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same decree which are applicable to this chair.
