Richard Youard Lectures in Legal History

- 1. The University accepts with gratitude the sum of £10,000 from Mr Richard Youard, and any further sums which may be contributed for the same purpose, to establish a fund, the net income of which shall be used to sponsor the Richard Youard Lectures in Legal History.
- 2. The fund shall be administered by the Board of the Faculty of Law or by a subcommittee established by the faculty board.
- 3. Any income not expended in any year shall be carried forward for expenditure in subsequent years.
- 4. Council shall have power to amend this decree, after consultation with the Law Board, provided that in any change of decree the object of the fund as stated in clause 1 above shall always be kept in view.
