Rouse Memorial Prize

- 1. The University accepts with gratitude from Randolph G. Rouse the sum of £200 to endow a Susan Mary Rouse Memorial Prize in memory of his mother.
- 2. The income from the endowment shall be applied to the award of an annual book prize to the undergraduate whose performance in a university examination, to be determined from time to time by Council, the examiners judge to be the best, provided that a candidate of sufficient merit presents himself or herself.
- 3. Income not so expended in any year shall be carried forward for expenditure in subsequent years.
