

Council Regulations 24 of 2002

Academic and Other Posts

Redesignated as regulations by Council on 11 July 2002

White's Professor of Moral Philosophy

1. White's Professor of Moral Philosophy shall lecture and give instruction in Philosophy with special regard to the Problems, Theories, and History of Ethics.
2. The professor shall be elected by an electoral board consisting of:
 - (1) the Vice-Chancellor, or, if the President of Corpus Christi College is Vice-Chancellor, a person appointed by Council on the occurrence of a vacancy to act as an elector on that occasion;
 - (2) the President of Corpus Christi College, or, if the President is unable or unwilling to act, a person appointed by the Governing Body of Corpus Christi College;
 - (3) a person appointed by the Governing Body of Corpus Christi College;
 - (4), (5) two persons appointed by Council;
 - (6) the Head of the Humanities Division, or his or her nominee;
 - (7)-(9) three persons elected by the Board of the Faculty of Philosophy.
3. The professor shall be subject to the General Provisions of the regulations concerning the duties of professors and to those Particular Provisions of the same regulations which are applicable to this chair. He or she shall give not less than thirty-six lectures or classes in the year, provided that this obligation may be reduced in exceptional circumstances with the approval of the faculty board concerned.
