

Astor Travel Fund Report – Professor Alison Gopnik

Professor Alison Gopnik visited Oxford from 13/06 to 21/06. She engaged in the following activities.

On Monday 16th she met with 3-4 graduate students in EP, and then had dinner with collaborators from UCL.

On Tuesday 17th she met with faculty from EP, then had lunch at Herford College with colleagues from philosophy. In the evening, she gave the Schmidt Prize lecture at the Natural History Museum (attended by ~100 people).

On Wednesday 18th she hosted a careers event (“ask me anything”) with graduate students in EP, which was attended by ~20 people. She then met with graduate students until 4pm, then gave a major seminar to the department in EP (~100 people attending), followed by a dinner with staff and students.

On Thursday 19th in the morning, she visited the OATML lab in Computer Science and met with staff / students. In the afternoon she met with 12-14 staff and students from EP. She then had dinner with EP staff.

On Friday 20th she had two residual meetings with EP students.
